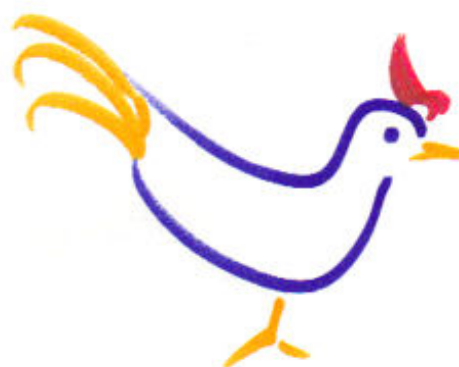

To complement the wine's freshness, a very low dosage was added at disgorging.
